

Calling All DANCING DADS AND THEIR DAUGHTERS

Now accepting registration For the 2017 Daddy Daughter Recital Dance

The Daddy/Daughter dance is a wonderful opportunity for fathers to spend quality time with their daughters. Together they will learn a dance and perform during the June recital.

Dancers ages 4 and up are welcome to participate in this year's Daddy/Daughter dance. For the recital the dancers wear a white dress and the dads wear a black suit. Since we know it can be frustrating locating a white dress we will have some options available for you to order.

Please read the following information very carefully before committing to the Daddy/Daughter Dance 2017.

1. The non-refundable fee to participate is \$99 per couple (includes all rehearsals, dress rehearsal and choreography notes and music). The fee is deducted automatically from your tuition account. This fee is non-refundable, so moms, make sure the dad actually knows about the dance, rehearsal dates and times and is fully committed before signing up.
2. The Daddy/Daughter dance is great fun but it also involves lifting your daughter (sometimes over your head-for smaller/younger dancers), memorizing choreography and committing to rehearsals. If you have back problems or other physical conditions that prohibit you from lifting your daughter, please check with your doctor and contact us before you register.
3. There are 5 rehearsals on the following Saturdays: February 11th, March 18th, April 8th, May 6th and June 3rd from 3:00-4:00pm plus a dress rehearsal.
4. At DDMA we believe in creating positive experiences and lasting memories. The Daddy Daughter dance is an experience that will last a lifetime! Spending time at rehearsal and working through choreography with your daughter is never time wasted. The memories of class, in fact, are as significant as performing the actual dance on stage in front of an audience. Try to remember this important fact if you feel confused, frustrated and tired during rehearsal. This time with your daughter is for you and your daughter... it is unique, important and very special.
5. All rehearsals are "Closed Rehearsals", meaning Moms, friends and family may not watch the daddy daughter rehearsals.
